Covid Health & Safety Plan

Spring Tour 2022, Walt Disney World, Orlando, Florida

The following guidelines are set in place to minimize spread of COVID-19 before, during and after the Spring 2022 Music Department trip to Orlando, Florida. While these precautions will be taken, please understand that there is inherent risk of transmission and that by registering for this trip, you understand and accept this risk. The inability to travel may result in monetary loss. Bangor Area School District will not reimburse any costs associated with this trip. This document supplements the current BASD Health and Safety Plan. All procedures described in the Bangor Area School District Health and Safety Plan and this document must be followed throughout the trip.

- Any student testing positive or required to quarantine, as determined through contact-tracing leading up to and including the day of departure, will not be able to travel to Florida. Bills have been paid by this point, so we will be unable to offer refunds for last-minute cancellations by students.
- When traveling (on plane, bus, etc.) students will have the same seat partner(s) throughout the trip, to minimize exposure.
- Masks will be mandatory for all students in all indoor locations (except for their own hotel room, where masks will be highly recommended) and required in any outdoor location in the parks where social distancing is not possible.
 - o All face coverings (whether disposable or reusable) should:
 - Be made with at least 2 layers of breathable material
 - Fully cover the nose and mouth and secure under the chin
 - Fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
 - Be secured with ties or ear loops and allow the Guest to remain hands-free
 - At this time, based on guidance from health authorities, neck gaiters, open-chin, triangle bandanas and face coverings containing valves, mesh material or holes of any kind are not acceptable face coverings.
- A room/rooms at the hotel will be made available for any students needing to quarantine during the trip.

- Students will not be allowed to socialize in rooms that are not their own. Common spaces in and around the hotel will be used instead.
- Should a student(s) test positive or display symptoms as outlined in the BASD COVID-19 health and safety plan, during the trip, they will not be permitted to fly home with the group. A parent/guardian will be required to travel to Orlando within 24 hours to pick up their student and stay with them until they can travel safely. A chaperone will stay with the student until the parent/guardian arrives. The cost of the student's room and chaperone room will be covered by the student's family. Additionally, the cost of changing flights for chaperones will also be covered by the student (\$160/night for hotel rooms, \$200 for change of flight). Should a student's family be unable or refuse to travel to Florida to retrieve their student, the family will be liable for ALL costs including rental car, substitute costs, and hotel rooms, and any medical expenses incurred.
- Should a student exhibit symptom(s) of COVID-19 within 2-14 days upon return from the trip, the school nurse must be notified.
